Park visitors are encouraged to take this opportunity to reflect on the importance of this day as a time for our community to pause and reflect on the tragic legacy of Canada's residential school system and honour the Survivors of residential schools, the children who never came home, their families and communities.

Indigenous educator Cree Crowchild will be present from 1:00 pm to 6:00 pm to share teachings and ceremonies.

Donation

Fifteen per cent of sales earned on Saturday, September 30 from admissions at the Zoo and The Leaf will be divided evenly and donated to the Orange Shirt Society and the Manitoba Aboriginal Sports & Recreation Council.

Orange lapel ribbons purchased from Dreamcatcher Promotions will be offered to visitors and guests at the Park Café, the Fire Node in the Indigenous Peoples Garden at The Leaf, and several locations within the Zoo with a request for donations. 100% of guest donations will be added to the amount donated to these organizations.
