The culinary team at Assiniboine Park & Zoo has prepared a special menu that pairs perfectly with craft beer for this event. Special menu items include pulled pork on a bun, soft pretzels served with a cheesy beer sauce, charcuterie boards, Bratwurst with sauerkraut, and more.

Food is available throughout the Zoo including at the Tundra Grill, Winston's Ice Cream Shoppe, and in two event tents located at the McFeetors Heavy Horse Centre and along the west side of the Zoo. Food items are not included in the cost of admission.
