Artistic Talents of Local Florists to be Showcased in Global Premiere of Fleurs de Villes WONDER at The Leaf in January

For immediate release: Winnipeg, December 17, 2025 – The Assiniboine Park Conservancy is pleased to announce the line-up of local florists that will be featured in the global premiere of **Fleurs de Villes WONDER**, on display at The Leaf from January 15 – 25, 2026. This will be the third Fleurs de Villes exhibition at The Leaf, following the success of ARTISTE (2025) and VOYAGE (2024).

"Fleurs de Villes has become a signature winter experience at The Leaf, and we're proud to continue that tradition with the global premiere of WONDER," said Gerald Dieleman, Senior Director of Horticulture, Assiniboine Park Conservancy. "This exhibition celebrates the creativity of our local floral community while inviting visitors to see the natural world through a new and imaginative lens. There's no better place to debut an experience inspired by the planet's most extraordinary landscapes."

Fleurs de Villes WONDER will feature fifteen exquisite floral mannequins inspired by iconic landscapes, rare botanical treasures, and awe-inspiring natural phenomena, brought to life by Winnipeg's most gifted floral designers. Their one-of-a-kind original creations will transform The Leaf into a living gallery that captures the magic, mystery, and magnificence of the natural world.

This incredible showcase of floral artistry will take visitors on a journey around the world, from the lavender fields of Provence (France) and the Great Barrier Reef (Australia) to the Amazon rainforest (South America), the monarch butterfly migration (Mexico), and more. The spectacular display will be set in the beautiful surroundings of the Mediterranean Biome and Babs Asper Display House at The Leaf.

Victoria Falls manneguin created by Osborne Florists

Inspired by Victoria Falls, the magnificent waterfall on the Zambezi River bordering Zambia and Zimbabwe, known for its dramatic spray and thunderous roar that creates a lush, misty environment for abundant flora.

Namib Desert manneguin created by Posh Pampas

Inspired by the vast Namib Desert in Namibia, one of the oldest deserts in the world, with striking sand dunes and rare desert-adapted plants that create dramatic contrasts of colour and texture.

Avenue of the Baobabs mannequin created by Meraki Fiori

Inspired by Madagascar's Avenue of the Baobabs, where towering, ancient trees rise like natural monuments, their massive trunks and sculptural silhouettes shaping a dramatic landscape.

Cliffs of Moher mannequin created by Prairie Creative

Inspired by Ireland's Cliffs of Moher, where rugged cliffs plunge into the Atlantic, waves crashing below, creating a breathtaking sense of raw, coastal majesty.
