APC volunteers enjoy flexible schedules, comprehensive training, and meaningful opportunities to connect with visitors, whether outdoors in the Park and Zoo or inside The Leaf. All volunteers receive cross-training to support roles across the Zoo, The Leaf, and Park, then have the flexibility to sign up for shifts at their preferred location.

Positions are available to anyone 14 years of age and older. Youth (age 14-18) are invited to apply for the Camp Crew, Teen Engagement Ambassador, and the Conservation Outreach and Leadership Team. A variety of other opportunities are available for adult volunteers.

- Animal Care Workforce Volunteers (animal science-related student opportunity)
- Camp Crew (youth)

Volunteers are asked to make a long-term commitment. A minimum commitment of 60 hours per year for adults and 40 hours per year for teens is required.

The application deadline for this season is May 31, 2026.
