Positions are available to anyone 14 years of age and older. Youth (age 14-18) are invited to apply for the Camp Crew, Teen Engagement Ambassador, and the new Conservation Outreach and Leadership Team. A variety of other opportunities are available for adult volunteers.

Volunteers are asked to make a long-term commitment. A minimum commitment of 60 hours for adults and 40 hours for teens is required per year.
