

SAVING ANIMALS FROM EXTINCTION SCAVENGER HUNT

Endangered species can include plants or animals that are likely to become extinct in the near future. Species are placed on a spectrum to determine how endangered they are. **Your challenge is to identify each animal's global endangered status. Answers can be found on the animal's identification sign.**

If the animal is found in Canada, check if there are differences in status between the global, federal, and provincial levels. If there is a difference, discuss why you think there might be a difference, or how the possible threats may be different throughout the animal's range.

Please note, animals occasionally might be taken off exhibit or moved for care or exhibit maintenance.
